## All Athlete Meeting

If your student athlete is planning on playing sports in any season next year, please plan on attending the "All Athlete Meeting" on August 11 at 6:30pm in the gym. Important updates, rules, and other information will be shared.

## First Days of Practice

High school fall sports will start on August 11 after the "All Athlete Meeting." Middle school fall sports can start on August 25. Throughout the year, practice schedules will be communicated through each individual coach. Please make sure you are looped into the communication platform that each program is using.

## Fall Sports Signup

All student athletes/parents must signup online at <https://www.nmcs.us/athletics> and electronically sign the Comet Commitment citizenship agreement form prior to the first day of practice.

## Athletic Physicals

All student athletes must have an updated physical on file in the main office prior to the first day of practice in order to participate. This physical must have been completed after April 15.

## Updated Athletic Fees

To help alleviate the burden of increased officials' fees across all sports and to better align with other MHSAA member schools, we will be increasing our athletic fees. The following fees will be implemented starting in the Fall of 2024...

- High School: \$75 first sport, \$50 second, \$25 third
- Middle School: \$50 first sport, \$25 second
- Family Cap: \$250

Please do not let these increases discourage athletic participation. If families are overly burdened by this additional cost, please contact Trey Reed. We are more than willing to work with families through service opportunities to be able to continually offer this athletic experience for your child.

## Volunteering

If you have a child participating in a sport, you are asked as a parent to volunteer for 3 events throughout the year. This can be in the form of the scoring table, concessions, tickets, etc. Please volunteer for 3 events per sport that your child plays.
