Exciting Partnership - Oxford Online Virtual

Over the course of the past couple years, we have explored different ways to provide more opportunities to our students. Many of our stakeholders have expressed a desire for their students to have access to more elective options. We currently partner and will continue to partner with Marion Public Schools to offer Computer, P.E., Art, Spanish, Music and Band to our elementary and middle school students through Shared Time. Additionally, we have partnered with Oxford Online Virtual to offer other electives in a variety of subjects including but not limited to agriscience, robotics, engineering, criminal justice, photography, technology/computer science, programming, coding foreign languages and a variety of other options. Due to teaching load, teacher availability

and capacity we cannot offer many of these exploratory options in-house. Oxford Online Virtual gives us the opportunity to offer these to our students through their online programs. Students will remain here on campus with their classmates but have the option to take classes in areas they are passionate about or have an interest in. We believe we have an obligation to serve our students well in preparing them for life after high school wherever God may lead them. As a school community, we have presented details of this partnership at our Town Hall meetings and at our Association meeting.
